- The Annual Buffalo Round Up is one of the most awe-inspiring events in the American West. Held annually, thousands of wild buffalo are rounded up on horseback and brought into a corral for inspection. A truly amazing event to witness, the Buffalo Round Up has become a popular tourist attraction over the past few years.
- Old Faithful, one of the most iconic landmarks in Yellowstone National Park, is an active geyser that shoots steam and hot water up to 185 feet in the air every 45 minutes or so. An incredible sight to behold, Old Faithful has been putting on this show since 1872 and continues to be one of Yellowstone's biggest attractions.
- Mt Rushmore is perhaps the most recognizable landmark in America and features four presidents' faces carved into its granite sides: George Washington, Thomas Jefferson, Theodore Roosevelt and Abraham Lincoln. Situated in South Dakota's Black Hills region, Mt Rushmore attracts millions of visitors each year who come to admire these enormous sculptures from afar or take pictures with their faces looming overhead.
- Crazy Horse Memorial is a large monument located near Mt Rushmore which honors the Lakota warrior Crazy Horse. Work began on the memorial in 1948 and continues today; when finished it will be 641 feet long by 563 feet wide – larger than Mt Rushmore itself! It will feature sculpted depictions of Crazy Horse riding a horse and pointing into the distance as well as 10 Native American elders sitting around him holding hands in prayer.
- Devil's Tower is another must-see destination located near Mt Rushmore that's been deemed a National Monument since 1906 due to its unique geological formation. Rising 867 ft above sea level this giant rock pillar was formed from molten lava which cooled into columns over time giving it its distinct tower shape – something that can't really be seen anywhere else!
- The Badlands provide hikers with stunning terrain that rivals any other environment found across North America. From its rugged buttes and spires to its steep canyons and plateaus this area provides plenty of opportunities for exploration along its trails while also offering spectacular views across miles upon miles of sagebrush-covered plains below.
- Custer State Park offers visitors some truly stunning scenery thanks to its lush grasslands, rolling hillsides, tranquil lakes and winding streams - all home to countless species of wildlife such as elk, deer, antelope and more!
- The Museum of the Rockies showcases some incredible artifacts from many different cultures throughout history including Native Americans from Montana itself as well as Egyptians from Ancient Egypt! You can also explore dinosaur fossils like never before thanks to interactive displays allowing **you to** get up close with ancient creatures such as T-Rexes or Triceratops bones that have been unearthed during excavations here at this museum – a truly an unforgettable experience!
